Objective: To provide an exposure on Ms- Word and Powerpoint

**Abstract:** Department of Science organized a "Hands on experience in MS Word & PowerPoint" for II semester BSc (PCM/CMS/EMS/PCsM) and selected BA students on 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> of January by Ms Jithy Lijo, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science and Applications, Christ Academy Institute for Advanced Studies in Ist floor Computer Lab, to provide a basic knowledge on MS-word and Powerpoint.

On 27<sup>th</sup> January 2020, Ms. Jithy Lijo gave a basic introduction of computers and explained about the MS-office and desktop applications of MS-office. Later, she explained in detail about various features of MS Word and how to format the text as per requirement. Ms Jithy Lijo also taught how to write a Resume and asked everyone to write a resume based on her input.


On 28th January 2020, she explained about Powerpoint and demonstrated its features. Later, the students were asked to experiment with the features learnt.

**Objective:** To help the students to understand fundamental principles of science in daily life.

**Abstract:** The department of science, CAIAS had organized a workshop "Chemistry for life" on 6/2/2020. The resource person for the day was "Prof M.R Chaya", KLEs S Nijalingappa College, Rajajinagar. She has an enormous teaching and research experience in the field of chemistry which spans over 24 years. All the students of BSC (PCM) participated in the program.

The event was initiated with a prayer sung by Rohini and Shilpashree, Bsc Sem 4. Vinutha B M, BSc Sem 4. presented the welcome address. In the workshop, Prof Chaya emphasized the role of chemistry in daily life. Everything on earth is madeup of chemicals: the food, the fiber and the products that we use in our daily life such as soap, detergents, perfumes etc. She demonstrated hands-on activities like preparation of soaps, detergents, phenyl, liquid hand wash and candles and the following household substances were prepared.

10 kg detergent

10 L phenyl

10 L liquid hand wash

1 kg soap

1 kg candle

All these were prepared by using eco friendly and easily available ingredients. Also, these demonstrations helped students to understand fundamental principles of science behind the preparation of these. This workshop motivated students to look at entrepreneurship as a career option too.

At the end of the session, a vote of thanks was proposed by Pallavi, BSc sem 2. Rev Fr Antony, director and Rev Fr Biju, administrator, CAIAS, graced the occasion.
