## Anveshana, 2-Day International Conference

### Report of the Event

Christ Academy Institute for Advanced Studies, BCA Department organized a two day international conference, Anveshana 2019, on "Envisioning the future for Knowledge Engineering" report.

The department initiated our discussions for holding the conference in association with Bangalore University and the Computer Society of India in the month of September 2018. Having got a green signal from the association, we started soliciting papers from the beginning of November 2018. A National, International Advisory committee and a Review committee was framed under the able guidance of Dr.M.Hanumanthappa and Rev.Fr.Antony, Director, CAIAS. The date for the conference was decided as March 8 and 9, 2019.

We received a total of 128 research papers including 2 international papers, out of which 62 were accepted after a diligent scrutiny that was done by a distinguished peer review committee.

On March 8, the conference started with an elegant inaugural session which was graced by delegates and participants from across international and national boundaries. Our Chief Guest, Dr. Venugopal K R, Hon.Vice Chancellor of Bangalore University, Guest of Honour, Dr. M. Hanumanthappa, Professor and Chairman, Department of Computer Science and Applications, BU, our keynote speakers Dr. Anand Paul from South Korea and Dr. Madhan Kumar Srinivasan from Accenture and Rev. Fr. Joice Manager of Christ Academy were the distinguished members of the dias.



Rev. Fr. Joice welcomed the gathering. Dr.Venugopal K R, declared the conference open by releasing the Book of Proceedings. He delivered the inaugural address. Then Dr. M Hanumanthappa addressed the gathering detailing about the proceedings of the conference.

This was followed by the plenary session. Dr. Madhan Kumar Srinivasan our First keynote speaker gave us an insight on data analytics and cloud computing. Dr. Anand Paul emphasized on the importance of Knowledge Engineering with a global perspective.

The technical sessions were spread over five tracks. On the first day, 23 papers were presented in the respective tracks. This also included Skype presentations, one from France and three from Srinagar, Kashmir.

The day 2 started with a panel discussion that was moderated by Dr. Kavya Naveen from RNSIT. The members of the panel discussion included Dr. Arun Kumar Thangavelu from VIT, Dr. Somashekar from Bangalore University, Dr. Manish Kumar from MSRIT and Mr. Shailesh Kumar Shivkumar from Infosys. The panel members' elaborated on the importance gathering knowledge, imbibing it and sharing. This is the order today in the age of Knowledge sharing, to achieve global objectives in the field of technology that can be transferred to everyday life, be it in medicine, engineering or finding solutions to civic problems. 'Work out loud' was the main take away from the panel discussion.

The technical session continued immediately after the panel discussion across four tracks which saw a total of 28 presentations. A stringent evaluation identified the best paper award.

Anveshana 2019 saw a lot of meaningful and intellectual deliberations resulting in knowledge sharing which will prove to be beneficial in the domain of research, thus envisioning the future for Knowledge Engineering in the years to come.
