


# **Communicative English – "Bridging the Gap in Communicative**


#### **Report of the Event**

The Course Book committee conducted Intra Departmental faculty orientation on 3/7/202 at 4:00 PM and Inter Departmental faculty orientation on 7/7/20 at 11: 00 AM to brief on the importance of English, the subject teachers' role in English Language Teaching and syllabus design for Communicative English (ADD ON Program). The Intra Departmental faculty orientation on 'Bridging the Gap' (A Webinar on the components of the Bridge Course for communication skills) was oriented by Mr. Sudhamshu Narayan. The resource person focused on the Bridge course syllabus, importance of grammar, LSRW and the influence of mother tongue in English Language. The orientation also motivated to gather inputs from the faulty members to structure the quality of the Bridge Course syllabus. The Inter Departmental Faculty orientation on 'Subject Teachers and English Language Teaching –What, Why and How?'
